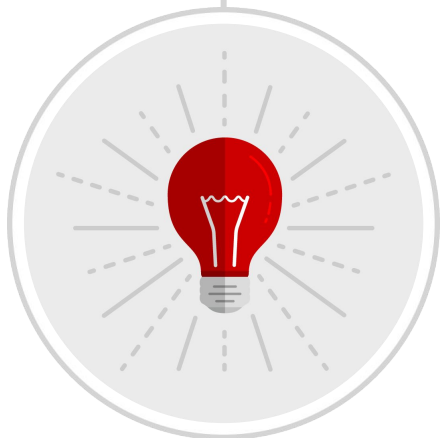

General Guidelines

- Use Ignition Spec v3
- Support FCOS as bootstrap and node host OS
- Avoid unnecessary divergence from OCP
- Align and standardize APIs in RHCOS and FCOS
- Platforms that are supported by both FCOS and RHCOS/OCP will be supported by OKD





Phase 0: Short Term (MVP)

Goal: Enable the community to install, test and try out a preview version of OKD



Phase 1: Mid Term (4.0 GA)

Goal: Release a first stable version for consumption by the community which is closely oriented at OCP





Phase 2: Long Term (post Initial V4 Release)

Goal: Enable more use-cases and setups; make OKD a superset of OCP components
